教學目標	This course will survey the field of social psychology, which is the study of how individuals' thoughts, feeling, or behaviors either (1) concern other people or (2) are shaped by social relationships. It aims to provide a general background of enduring topics in the field. The topics include: the self and self-esteem, stereotyping and prejudice, attitudes, conformity, close relationships, aggression, prosocial behavior, and behavior in groups. We will also review classic studies and recent research. Students are expected to be actively involved in the discussions and exercises.
每週課程內容 及教學方法	The course will have two elements. First, I will give an overview of the general background of the following topics. Second, we will discuss some questions relevant for addressing a variety of social problems. Students will be expected to read course materials (scientific journal articles and book chapters) and write short weekly papers before class. In class, students will be expected to actively participate in discussion.
