教學目標	Qualitative research is an essential tool for deeper probing of diverse educational phenomena and for designing effective educational systems and schools. In the educational research areas, ethnography, case studies, action research, discourse analysis, narrative inquiry, and Actor Net Theory all have contributed insight and depth to our understanding of the structural, managerial, and environmental factors embedded in the educational sector. Given this, every independent researcher, need to understand the philosophy of qualitative, non-statistical social science research, focusing on how to design methods of qualitative research and how to conduct the analysis. The main objective of this course is to empower the researcher to critically understand and employ research methods through various forms of qualitative methods, and then to provide the fundamental skills for the researcher to develop their own research work in the future.  Expected learning outcomes After this course the student is expected to be able to:  * Explain the central principles and steps of qualitative research with respect to the data analysis methods covered during the course.  * Clarify the design and ethical implications of qualitative research.  * Grasp and perform the central steps of the qualitative methods covered during the course.  * Present and discuss, in oral and/or written form, one's own and others application of the methods covered during the course.
